

GED *Fast Track* Course!

If you are a student who reads at or above the 9th grade level *and* can perform basic math calculations (decimals, fractions, beginning algebra, etc.) you should enroll in the GED Fast Track program.

All students interested in the Fast Track program will need to attend an orientation and screening session. At this session you will take the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE). This assessment will determine if you qualify for the Fast Track program. Fast Track is available to any student who meets the eligibility requirements.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be age 21 or older
- Must call or email to reserve a seat
- Must be able to attend and complete screening
- Reading and math skills must be a grade equivalent of 9.0 or higher
- Students must be able to attend all 6 weeks, no less than 6 hours per week

Screening: One Day Only! Wednesday, June 25

- Morning session starts at 9 AM, ends at 1 PM
- Evening Session starts at 6 PM, ends at 9PM

You must be able to participate from start to end time.

Classes begin the week of July 7 and end the week of August 11.
Morning classes will be held Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday mornings, 9 AM – 1 PM
